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Junior Duck Stamp Classroom Presentations in Humboldt County

The U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service in conjunction with the Sacramento National Wildlife Refuge, Humboldt National Wildlife Refuge, and California Waterfowl Association has received a grant to offer students in Humboldt County in 1st -6th grades a free 1-hour Junior Duck Stamp Program (JDS) in their individual classrooms. This program provides students with hands-on, inquiry-based learning that targets some of the Common Core and Next Generation Science Standards as your students learn about wetland and waterfowl conservation.

Students will learn about the loss of natural wetlands in California, waterfowl biology and identification, and follow up by creating their own piece of waterfowl artwork to submit to the Federal Junior Duck Stamp Contest. Free handouts included with the program include: a JDS curriculum for teachers and waterfowl identification cards for students. Those teachers who submit their students' artwork will receive certificates to award to their students.
