Free classroom Junior Duck Stamp presentations are available for schools and other groups (scouts, afterschool, homeschool, etc) in Glenn, Colusa, Butte, and southern Tehama Counties from the Sacramento National Wildlife Refuge Complex. Have a naturalist come to your classroom and provide your students with hands-on science and art with lessons about waterfowl, wetlands, and migration. Final projects have students creating images that are entered in the annual state contest (postmark date March 15). Students and teachers will receive free materials to assist them with drawing and learning about waterfowl, wetlands, and conservation.
