Requirements


Cooperator is encouraged to check the fence/ water conditions prior to bidding. Some boundary fences may be in poor condition due to snow and/or high water. Should the cooperator choose to repair the permanent barbed wire fence, the materials will be provided by the US Fish & Wildlife Service. It is preferred that the cooperator use their own materials and keep track of what they use on the NWR and the US Fish & Wildlife Service will reimburse the cooperator for the materials. Should the cooperator choose to use electric fence, the cooperator will be required to use their own materials.

* If necessary, cooperator will be required to haul water to the unit or remove cattle.

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


-  Unit 1- Approx. 80 Acres
