

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service is seeking public comment for the development of updated or new hunt plans for Horicon, Fox River and Green Bay National Wildlife Refuges.

All three refuges currently have comprehensive conservation plans (CCP's) completed which identify goals, objectives, and broad strategies for refuge management which includes the hunt programs. However, staff would like to consider any additional public input before starting the environmental assessment (EA) process necessary to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) and the further development of more detailed draft hunt plans for these refuges.
