


Requirements

The cooperators will be required to maintain the fence. Cooperator is encouraged to check the condition of the fences prior to bidding. Should the cooperators need to repair the permanent barbed wire fence, the materials will be provided by the US Fish & Wildlife Service. It is preferred that the cooperators use their own materials and keep track of what they use on the WPA and the US Fish & Wildlife Service will reimburse the cooperators with new materials. Should the cooperators choose to use electric fence, the cooperators will be required to use their own materials.
