1. Fields designated to be corn shall be planted with a un-treated and non-GMO seed. It is the responsibility of the cooperator to purchase and plant the correct seed. There will be corn fields designated as delayed harvest. These fields will be designated Sept. 1. They can be harvested after March 1. **In 2021 9.6 acres will be delayed harvest. In 2022 there will be 10.2 acres delayed harvest. In 2023 9.6 acres will be delayed harvest.**
2. Hay fields may be cut one time between Aug. 1 and Aug. 15. Bales will be removed immediately. Bales left on the area after Oct. 1 will become the property of the U. S. F & W Service.
3. The cooperator will use end rows on all crop fields. Field boundary markers will be respected. Field size shall not increase. Care shall be taken when spraying Roundup on crop fields, so as not to over-spray on adjacent cover.
4. Acreage figures appearing in the lease may not be the basis for federal farm program payments. It shall be the operators' responsibility to determine the extent of the farm program benefits that are available.
5. Only herbicides with approved PUP's may be used.
6. Neonicotinoids are prohibited (treated seed)
7. Insecticide use is prohibited.
8. Fall tillage is not allowed.


