Stocking rate

Graze unit G-1 for a period of 45 days beginning May 1, 2021 with 75 cow/calf pairs or 120 yearlings. More livestock for a shorter period of time is permitted and needs to be approved prior to grazing.

Graze unit G-2 for a period of 30 days beginning August 1, 2021 with 75 cow/calf pairs or 120 yearlings. More livestock for a shorter period of time is permitted and needs to be approved prior to grazing.


Requirements

The permittee will be required to maintain all fences. Materials needed to repair the permanent fence will be supplied by the Refuge. Temporary electric fencing may be used in places and must be removed immediately after grazing. The refuge will not supply temporary fencing. To meet the goals of this plan and our habitat improvement objectives, moving livestock on the above mentioned dates is **critical**. Deviations from these move dates without manager notification will have negative impacts on future grazing opportunities.

Special Note: Pay particular attention to **water conditions and fence conditions** and inspect the units prior to bidding.
