Please note the following requirements:

- 1. Art must be able to be hung on a wall.**
 - 2. Art will be displayed in a public space.**
 - 3. Child's name, grade level, and title of piece will be on display.**
 - 4. Art size is limited to 24" x 36" to ensure there is enough wall space for the entries.**
 - 5. Artists must provide a hanger securely attached, to ensure the art can be hung safely on the wall.**
 - 6. Artists must place their name, grade level and title of piece securely on the back of the piece.**
 - 7. Artists must drop their art off at the Don Edwards San Francisco Bay National Wildlife Refuge, Environmental Education Center in North San Jose or make arrangements to mail it safely to the Center. More details to follow once your entry form is submitted.**
