
Proposed Recreational Boating

Proposed restrictions in Draft CD:

- In ~4000 acre Topock Marsh, it is proposed to only allow 30hp and no-wake speeds.
- A 2-mile (~500 acre) extension to the 17.5-mile existing regulations is proposed.
- A designation of no-wake in the 2-mile extension is proposed.

Key Points:

- No new restrictions are placed on the California side of the River in the area of the southern ~2 mile expansion.
- No new restrictions will be applied to the 17.5-mile stretch (between I-40 and the existing Southern buoy line.)
- No new areas will be closed or cut off to through-passage.



Draft Compatibility Determination (CD)
