<b>Station Name</b>	<b>Sewee Visitor and Environmental Education Center/Cape Romain NWR, Francis Marion NF</b>
<b>Job Title</b>	<b>Grounds and Facilities Maintenance Volunteer</b>
<b>Qualifications</b>	Willingness to become knowledgeable about the Cape Romain National Wildlife Refuge and Francis Marion National Forest. Ability to do physically demanding work for extended periods of time in adverse weather conditions. Work will involve stooping, bending, and lifting. Ability to use hand tools, push and riding mowers and trimmers. Willingness to participate in on-the-job training for riding mowers. Must possess a valid state driver's license.
<b>Duties and Responsibilities</b>	<p>Mowing, trimming and weeding of Center grounds. Weeding, mulching and planting in pollinator gardens. Weeding, mulching and trimming grounds shrubbery. Maintenance of picnic tables, benches, porches, and outside trash and recycle bins. Maintenance of boardwalks. Trimming vegetation and clearing boardwalks of debris along the Nebo Walking Trail. Cleaning and maintaining interpretive signs along walking trail. Cleaning front glass at the Red wolf viewing platform.</p> <p>Volunteer may encounter hot and humid temperatures, biting insects, snakes, briars and other prickly vegetation, and poison ivy.</p>
<b>Time commitment</b>	Minimum of 4 hours each week.
