Bear River Refuge Closes Wildlife Education Center for One Day, Saturday 26, 2015

Due to a temporary shortage of staff, the Wildlife Education Center will be closed Saturday, September 26, 2015 (Auto Tour Route remains open). Staff resources are currently stretched thin due to assisting national wildland firefighting efforts in California and Idaho. Refuge Project Leader, Bob Barrett, apologizes for the inconvenience and will re-open the center Monday, September 28 at 8:00 a.m., when regular hours resume. The James V. Hansen Wildlife Education Center is located at 2155 W. Forest St., Brigham City, one block west of I-15 at Exit 363. The Center offers interactive exhibits, wetland diorama, 2 miles of outdoor trail, and is open Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.- 5 p.m., and Saturdays, 10 a.m.- 4 p.m. The Auto Tour Route is open daily, from sunrise to sunset to provide outdoor recreation opportunities to visitors and is FREE.
