

# Wyoming Endangered Species Quiz

This year, we celebrate the 40th Anniversary of the Endangered Species Act (ESA). President Nixon signed the ESA into law on December 28, 1973. Congress understood that, without protection from human actions, many of our nation's living resources would become extinct. Both plants and animals can be listed as threatened or endangered.

Circle E (endangered), T (threatened), or D (delisted) to indicate each plant or animal's status in the State of Wyoming. (Keep in mind that a plant or animal's listing may vary from state to state.) Ask a naturalist for an answer key to check your score. Further challenge yourself by asking a naturalist for bonus questions.
