October Water Conditions at Bear River Refuge

Bear River Refuge's water conditions and waterfowl numbers look favorable for the general Waterfowl Opener Saturday, October 3, according to wildlife biologist Howard Browers. Hunt Units that are presently full include 1A, 2B, 2C, 2D, and the northern portions of Unit 3, Duckville Area (3- A, I, J, K, H). Unit 3B is still filling and Unit 9 is receiving water.

Launching from the Willard State Park public boat launch is possible at this time. Refuge staff will continue to fill Unit 6 and Block C as river flow allows.
