Employment will last 8 weeks: June 1 – July 26, 2014**

Are you between the ages of 15 and 19, and currently enrolled in high school? Would you like to spend your summer working, learning and earning in the outdoors? Would you like a fun job where your efforts make a difference for wildlife and the environment? If you answered **YES** to these questions, the Youth Conservation Corps may be right for you.

To be eligible for the Wichita Mountains YCC Program, applicants must:

- ✓ Be between the ages of 15 (by June 1, 2014) and 19 (not age 19 before August ?, 2014) and currently enrolled in school
- ✓ Be a permanent resident of the United States, its territories or possessions
- ✓ Be available to work 40 hours per week (7:30 a.m.- 4 p.m.), Monday - Friday for the full 8-week period
- ✓ Be able to get to and from the Refuge Visitor Center
- ✓ Possess a Social Security card prior to the first working day of the YCC program
- ✓ Have the written permission of a parent or legal guardian to work
