


Cow Trap Marsh Trail

This levee trail traverses high, intermediate, and low marsh zones. Wading birds, wintering snow geese, and migrating shorebirds use these areas. Watch for raccoons feeding along the water's edge, and alligators in the pot holes.

To local ranchers, Cow Trap Lakes were known as deadly bogs for cattle caught in low-lying lands during floods and hurricanes. Today, biologists recognize these refuge estuaries as marine nurseries for shell and fin fish.
