
The Prairie Science Class

A Partnership between
the Fergus Falls School District and
the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service



The Prairie Science Class (PSC) uses the local prairie wetlands ecosystem to blend science, math, language arts, health, and art.

- Students are bussed to the Prairie Wetlands Learning Center and back for half of their school day, every day of the school year.
- The remainder of their subjects are taught to them at Cleveland School.
- PSC students spend part or all of their time at the prairie outside in the field, every day of the school year.
- Fergus Falls School District teachers instruct PSC students at Cleveland Elementary and at the prairie.
- U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service educators provide indoor and outdoor classroom leadership weekly.
