

Portage to and paddle across Paddle, Lure, Pot, MJ's, Pond, Balloon, Lonely, Kuviak, Junco, and Kinglet Lakes. Swanson River Canoe Area is designated wilderness. No motorized equipment or vehicles. Please pack out litter.
