

Lake Public Access: Mile 75.3 Sterling Hwy, 5.3 miles (mile 14.3) east on Skilak Lake Loop Road, 1 mile southwest on Lower Skilak Campground Road, or Mile 75.3 Sterling Hwy, 10.6 miles (mile 8.6) east on Skilak Lake Loop Road, 2 miles south to the upper Skilak Campground. Facilities at Lower Skilak Campground include toilets, 14 campsites, tables, firepits, water, and boat launch. Facilities at Upper Skilak Campground include 26 campsites, tables, firepits, water, toilets, and boat launch.
