

Lake Public Access: Can be accessed between August 10 and mid October by driving 22 miles down Mystery Creek Road (four wheel drive recommended) when the gate is open, and then canoeing or hiking to the lake. Also accessible by float plane, ski plane, snowmobile, and skiing. A public use cabin is located on the lake with wood stove, outhouse, and no fee. This cabin is first-come first-served. No trash pickup; please pack out litter.
