Public Access Permitted on West Beach Only

DAYLIGHT USE ONLY

Open the Saturday Before Memorial Day through Labor Day

PERMITTED ACTIVITIES

- **Wildlife Observation**
 - **Photography**
- **Family-Oriented Beach Activities**
 - **Sunbathing**
 - **Picnicking**
 - **Leashed Pets**

Hunting is permitted on the entire island in accordance with Refuge regulations.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- **Camping**
- **Open Fires/Fireworks**
 - **Shore Fishing**
- **Alcohol Possession/Consumption**
 - **Glass Containers**
 - **Littering**
- **Public Access to Concrete Piers**
 - **Staging for Scuba Diving**

The Refuge does not have an approved fishing plan, therefore shore fishing is prohibited at this time. Island public use will be evaluated annually.
