- Closed to all other hunting* and trapping from March 16 until the day after the close of the State duck hunting season.
- * Except spring wild turkey hunting.
- Voluntary Avoidance October 15 to the end of the State duck hunting season.

Crooked Slough Boat Speed/Distance Regulation
5 mph when within 100 feet of craft that is anchored or going 5 mph or less.


