# Waterfowl Hunting Regulations

Waterfowl hunting on Sand Lake National Wildlife Refuge is allowed only in the perimeter boundary, open road, right-of-way closures marked on site or on the map on the reverse of this brochure. No interior waterfowl hunting is permitted. All state, federal, and refuge waterfowl hunting regulations apply. ### Road right-of-ways

- Road right-of-ways adjacent to the refuge are open to hunting except for the closed roads listed below.
- Legally taken waterfowl may be retrieved (unarmed) from within a zone 100 yards inside the refuge boundary, extending along the entire perimeter of the refuge. The end of the retrieval zone is unmarked.

The following road right-of-ways are closed to hunting:

- Brown County Highway 16 from the south refuge boundary and extending five (5) miles north to 114<sup>th</sup> Street.
- State Highway 10 as it crosses the refuge.
- Brown County Highway 5 as it crosses the refuge (Hecla Grade).
- The section of 117<sup>th</sup> Street as it crosses the refuge and marked on the reverse map (Weismantel Grade).
- Those hunting from the road right-of-way may park their vehicles in the nearest designated parking area.

### Reminders

- Use only non-toxic shot.
- All hunters age 16 and over must have a current federal duck stamp.
- All guns must be unloaded and cased if driving on interior refuge roads.
