


ISLAND MARBLE CCAA

Possible Conservation Measures for Landowners



CHOOSE TO BUFFER

*(OPTION STRONGLY ENCOURAGED, BUT NOT REQUIRED)

To protect any caterpillars and chrysalises immediately outside the patches:

Maintain at least a 5 foot vegetative buffer around patch, don't disturb until after the flight season the following year

MAINTAINING YOUR PATCHES:

- Don't use insecticides within or adjacent to patches
- Herbicides limited to spot spraying in patches
- No livestock/grazing in patches
- Don't mow/drive in/trample patches

LONG TERM PATCH MANAGEMENT OPTIONS:

- 1** Re-establish in place (remove any mustard in spring, till the site in the fall to refresh patch)
- 2** Move to a new location (remove any mustard in spring before the flight season, till the new site in the fall)
- 3** Alternating continuous habitat (establish a 2nd patch in the year before they will be decommissioning the first patch)

Reduce your habitat patch size commitment by 1/3 if you address deer browsing in created patches

DEER MANAGEMENT OPTIONS INCLUDE:

- Adequate deer fencing
- Lethal removal (based on suitability of ownership)
