Deadline Correction for Information Submission for Island Marble Butterfly Status Review

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has announced a correction to the deadline for information submission regarding the status review of the Island Marble butterfly (*Euchloe ausonides insulanus*). The correct deadline is April 6, 2015

Historically, the Island Marble butterfly (*Euchloe ausonides insulanus*) was rare and restricted in its range. It was believed extinct for nearly 100 years until it was rediscovered on San Juan Island, Washington, in 1998, and Lopez Island, Washington, in 2005.

The Service will continue to work with the interagency Island Marble Recovery Team, university researchers, conservation organizations, landowners on San Juan Island and the public to increase awareness and implement conservation measures to conserve the butterfly.
