2009 DEER HUNT INFORMATION

WILLIAM L. FINLEY NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE

HUNTING IS ALLOWED BY SPECIAL REFUGE PERMIT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH OREGON STATE REGULATIONS, AND SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- **Hunting for DEER ONLY** during specified archery or shotgun seasons on Refuge (see dates below). No other hunting is permitted.
- In addition to the **self-service Refuge permit**, hunters must carry a current Oregon state hunting license and deer tag. Hunters 17 years and under must carry a hunter safety card.
- Hunting is permitted seven days a week, **½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset**.
- **NO overnight camping or parking** is permitted on the Refuge.
- All vehicles must remain parked in designated areas (please see map for locations).

PROCEDURES FOR SELF-SERVICE HUNT KIOSK

Each hunter must complete the following **DAILY**:

- Two self-service kiosks are located on the Refuge (please see map).
- Before hunt:**
- Fill out the top half (“A” portion) of the permit and deposit in box at the hunt kiosk.
 - The bottom half (“B” portion) of the permit is to be signed and carried while hunting.
- After hunt:**
- Fill in the appropriate information on the “B” portion and deposit in box at hunt kiosk.
