Volunteers are especially needed to help staff the hatchery's Visitor/Environmental Education Center. Duties include meeting and greeting the public, helping with the gift shop, assisting with tours, light housekeeping, etc. We also offer opportunities to help with our trout production team, including helping to clean raceways, feed fish, move fish/load trucks, working with our threatened and endangered species program and more!

In exchange for service, volunteers may be able to receive a free campsite with water, electric, sewer hookup, FREE WiFi and laundry facilities. Phone service is also available at each site at the camper's expense. All training and uniforms are also provided, and our staff truly have a wonderful time working together!

Volunteers are welcome year-round, hours are part-time, and scheduling can be flexible! For those living on one of the campsites, hours are estimated at 20 to 24 per person, per week (more hours can be accommodated if the person is interested). For all others, any and all time is greatly appreciated! Whether it's one day per week or one day per month, working at the new Visitor/Environmental Education Center or outside with our hatchery crew is a great and fun way to give back in a fun, appreciated way!
