AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF APPORTIONMENT OF
\$370,396,740 OF THE APPROPRIATION FOR DINGELL-
JOHNSON SPORT FISH RESTORATION (CFDA NO. 15.605) TO
THE STATES, THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO,
GUAM, THE U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS, AMERICAN SAMOA, THE
COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS,
AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019

Pursuant to the Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration Act, as amended (16 U.S.C. 777 et seq.), we have, at this time apportioned \$370,396,740 to the States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the District of Columbia. The funds so apportioned are based on the amount credited during Fiscal Year 2018 to the Sport Fish Restoration Account. This includes \$1,251,542 in Sport Fish Restoration Funds that were reverted from previous year apportionments. Also included in this apportionment is \$24,124,248 that was sequestered in 2018 and is now available. A preliminary apportionment of \$251,689,0733 was made on December 7, 2018, and is included as part of this final apportionment. Also included in this revised tabulation is \$5,000,000 in unapportioned Sport Fish Restoration funds resulting from a calculation error. The funds are available for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2018, and are available for the period of time specified in the Act.

The amounts apportioned to the States are as provided by Section 4 of the Act, and adjusted so that no State shall receive more than 5 percent or less than 1 percent of the total amount apportioned. The amounts apportioned to the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the District of Columbia are as provided by Section 12 of the Act.

Therefore, in accordance with the above, the amended apportionment of Dingell-Johnson Sport Fish Restoration funds for Fiscal Year 2019 is as shown on the enclosed tabulation.
