Guided Nature Walks

August 2014 - Nocturnal Wildlife

Please join Sam Cuenca with the U.S. Forest Service, Ray Miller, Mellen Colberg, Liz Wolf, and other bat experts for a guided nature walk on **Wednesday, August 20th from 7-9pm** to learn about bats and other nocturnal wildlife.

Bring: hardhat or helmet, headlamp, camp chair, and wear long pants and boots for hiking through the cave.

Directions: *From Yreka:* Head south on I-5 to Grenada. Take left onto A-12 road for about 17 miles. Look for flagging on left at dirt parking area to Barnum Cave. *From Weed:* Drive about 12 miles on Hwy 97 and take left onto A-12 road for about 2 miles. Look for flagging on right at dirt parking area to Barnum Cave.

If interested in carpooling, meet at Yreka Fish and Wildlife Office parking lot (1829 South Oregon Street, Yreka) at 6:30pm.
