Guided Nature Walks

September 2016 - Bats and Caves

Please join the U.S. Forest Service and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for an evening with local bat experts on **Wednesday, September 21st** from **7-9pm** to learn about bats and explore their cave dwelling habitat.

Bring: hardhat or helmet, headlamp, camp chair, and wear long pants and boots for hiking through the cave.

Directions: *From Yreka:* Head south on I-5 to Grenada. Take left onto A-12 road for about 17 miles. Look for flagging on left at dirt parking area to Barnum Cave. *From Weed:* Drive about 12 miles on Hwy 97 and take left onto A-12 road for about 2 miles. Look for flagging on right at dirt parking area to Barnum Cave.

If interested in carpooling, meet at Yreka Fish and Wildlife Office parking lot (1829 South Oregon Street, Yreka) by 6:15 pm.
