

U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Guided Nature Walks August 15th, 2012 - Nocturnal Nightlife

Please join Sam Cuenca with the US Forest Service and Bob Carey from the FWS for a guided nature walk on **Wednesday, August 15th from 7-9pm** to learn about bat ecology, the role of Barnum Cave and more. If interested in carpooling meet at Yreka Forest Service parking lot at 6:30pm, otherwise meet at **Barnum Cave**

What to bring:

Hardhat, headlamp; 2 sources of light, longs pants, boots and a sense of adventure!

Be prepared to hike.

This event may include moderate to vigorous hiking

Directions:

From Yreka: Go south on I-5 to Grenada. Take highway A-12 approximately 15 miles, passed Big Springs. Turn right to a dirt road between a deer crossing sign and white posts on the road shoulder. Signs will be posted to direct you.

From Mt. Shasta: North on Interstate 5 to Weed. Get on highway 97 and travel 12.5 miles to A-12. Signs will direct you.
