## Guided Nature Walks

### August 2013 - Nocturnal Wildlife

Please join Sam Cuenca with the U.S. Forest Service and Bob Carey from the Yreka Fish and Wildlife Office for a guided nature walk on **Wednesday, August 21<sup>th</sup> from 7-9pm** to learn about bats and other nocturnal wildlife.

**Bring:** hardhat (if you have), headlamp, long pants, hiking boots for moderate hiking.

**Directions:** *From Yreka:* Head south on I-5 to Grenada. Take left onto A-12 road for about 17 miles. Look for flagging on left at dirt parking area to Barnum Cave. *From Weed:* Drive about 12 miles on Hwy 97 and take left onto A-12 road for about 2 miles. Look for flagging on right at dirt parking area to Barnum Cave.

If interested in carpooling, meet at Yreka Fish and Wildlife Office parking lot (1829 South Oregon Street, Yreka) at 6:30pm.

\*Learn about local and fall migratory songbirds at the next walk on September 18<sup>th</sup> from 9-11am at Greenhorn Park\*
